



P360 & Rouse Hill Rams Netball Injury Management Procedure 2018

Player is injured while playing; attending training or at Club Function

Injury is reported to P360 by RH Rams Representative (Monday AM)

Injury is deemed as not considered "serious" and minimal treatment would be required.

Injured person can be treated at a P360 Clinic (Marsden Park or Rouse Hill Sports) and given access to Sports Club Discount.

Injured person is not eligible for Club-Managed Sports Insurance program, however if they wish to make a claim the RH Rams Committee will provide injured person with the appropriate paperwork to complete claim themselves. Injury is deemed as "serious" and eligible to attend RH Rams Emergency Injury Clinic on Monday PM. Emergency Injury Clinic appointments are done Obligation-Free for members of Rouse Hill Rams Netball.

NB. Players' Injury must be serious enough to miss at least one game

Injured Person attends the Emergency
Injury Clinic appointment & is provided with
treatment plan & Netball NSW Sports
Insurance paperwork.

If choosing to utilise Sports Insurance, paperwork MUST be completed before first treatment session, if not, the injured person is required to pay upfront for their treatment until paperwork is returned.

NB. Player cannot return to playing until paperwork completed & given clearance by P360's treating clinician

Netball NSW Player Injury Insurance Claim submitted to V-Insurance Group

Player/Club is invoiced for Players' treatment at P360



Player/Club receive payment from V-Insurance & pay P360 invoice Injured Person attends their treatment program at a P360 Clinic.

NB. Should the injured person No Show or Cancel on day of Appointment they will be invoiced directly for the No Show or Cancellation Fee Amount



Injured Person completes their treatment program at a P360 Clinic, is discharged & cleared to return to play.
